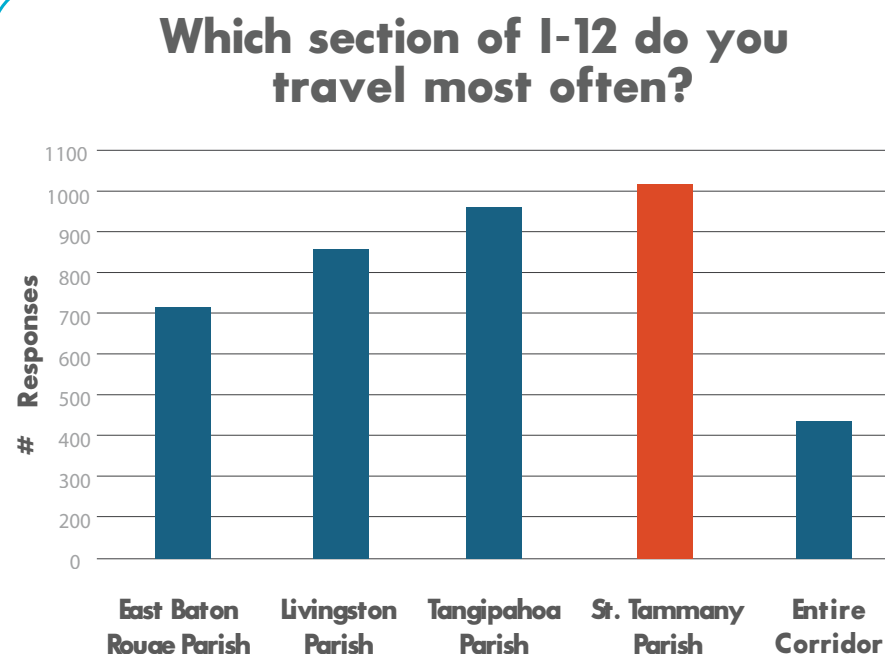

WHICH OPTION BEST DESCRIBES YOU?

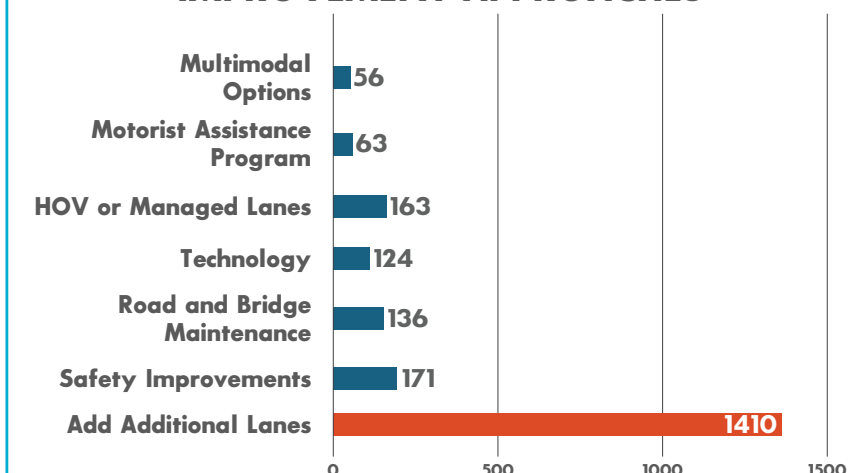
General Public: 1808

Recommendations to Consider for Statewide Improvement:

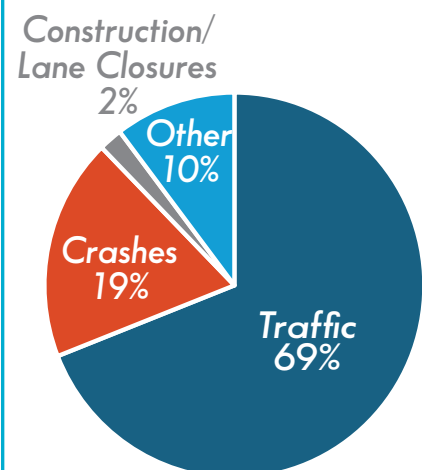
- Widen the whole corridor to 3 lanes.
- State police to enforce safe driving, and hold violators accountable.
- Need Commercial Motor Vehicle (CMV) only lane.
- Ramps are too short!

IMPROVEMENT APPROACHES



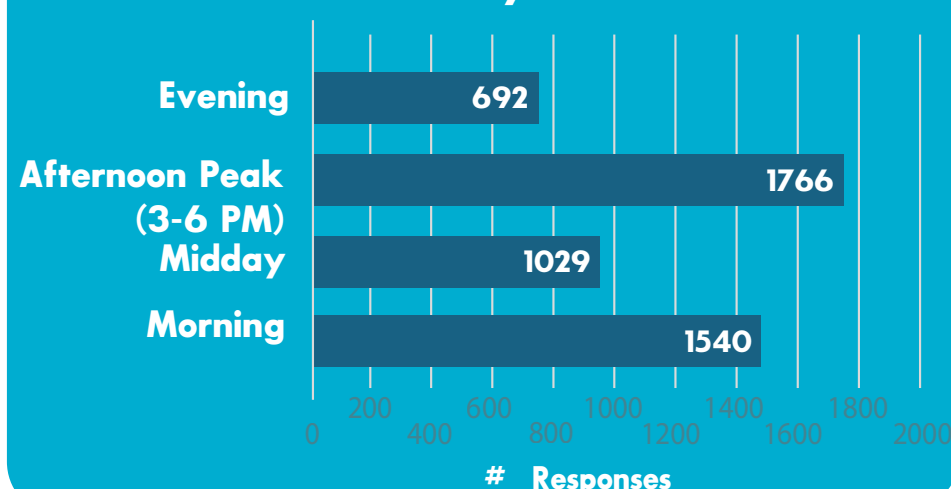
Graph values = the number of respondents who ranked each category #1.

What Times of Day Do You Travel?

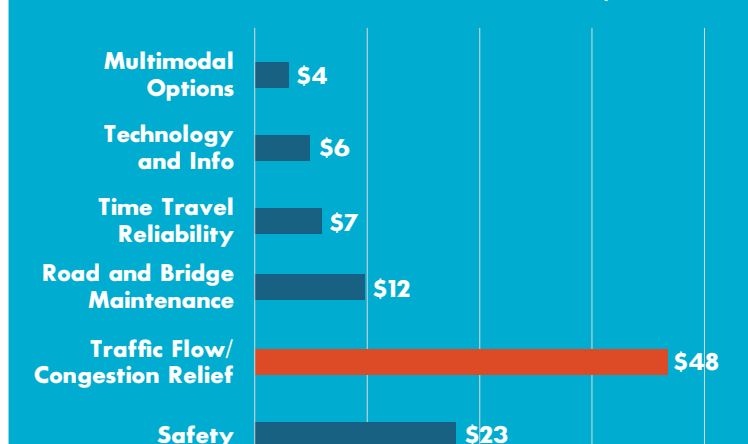


Congestion and crashes/vehicle breakdowns are top two issues impacting trips.

Without congestion more than half of daily commutes would take less than 30 minutes.

Up to 10 minutes delay is acceptable by nearly half of travelers during a daily commute.
