SUBJECT: LIMITS OF MAINTENANCE FOR INTERSTATE OVERPASSES ON OFF-SYSTEM ROADS

- 1. **PURPOSE:** To establish the limits of maintenance for Interstate Overpasses for off- system roads.
- 2. SCOPE: This directive covers the general policy and operating guidelines for maintaining Interstate Overpasses on Off-system roads and responsibilities of the districts field personnel.
- **3. POLICY:** DOTD's limits of maintenance on all Interstate Overpasses will be determined by the Right-of-Way limits of the interstate and the DOTD Right-of-Way limits along the Off-system road.
- 4. **RESPONSIBILITY:** The District shall be responsible for:
 - A. Determining the limits of maintenance for each bridge according to this policy
 - B. Document in the bridge files and highway inventory records
 - C. Perform appropriate maintenance per the Department standards
- 5. OTHER ISSUANCES AFFECTED: All directives, memoranda, or instructions issued heretofore in conflict with this directive are hereby rescinded.
- 6. **EFFECTIVE DATE:** This directive shall become effective immediately.
