Key Message: Contract Admin Pilots and e-Ticketing Progress

June marks another milestone for the LADOTD e-Construction initiative as we move forward with smarter, more streamlined project oversight tools. The HeadLight Contract Administration software has officially received the green light for use on pilot projects, bringing us closer to a unified digital workflow for managing estimates, change orders, and funding. These pilots will help refine the platform before expanding department-wide—and they're an important step toward reducing paperwork, improving transparency, and saving time in the field.

In support of another major initiative, HaulHub recently hosted two live training sessions tailored for LADOTD personnel and CE&I staff to prepare for broader adoption of the app. These sessions focused on how to track material deliveries, view digital tickets, and ensure quality data entry directly from the job site. To keep the momentum going, two additional trainings are scheduled—this time geared toward contractors and material suppliers—to boost confidence and consistency across all users. With full-scale e-Ticketing implementation continuing across all projects, these efforts are vital to ensuring a smoother, more connected construction process for everyone involved.

HeadLight Hero of the Month: Jack Moore, District 05-Unit 255


H.015323.6: LA 577: Joe's Bayou Rd - 1500 ft N I-20

Jack's documentation tells the story of the project with clarity and consistency. He made excellent use of HeadLight's tools, capturing over 20% of all project observations as images. His use of the HeadLight Materials to record sampling and testing data especially his use of the Structural Concrete form to document cylinder breaks, slump, and air tests—provided a reliable and wellorganized trail of material quality assurance.
