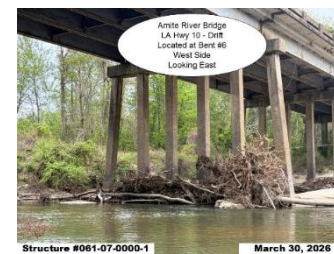
**NTBA** first establishes the horizontal control for the project using NTRIP service LEICA SmartNET or other available published control. The horizontal datum to be used for the project is NAD 83 Louisiana State Plane Coordinate System South Zone (1702), US Feet. **NTBA** recovers the project benchmark near the bridge for predetermined vertical control for the project. In the event there isn't pre-determined vertical control for the bridge or the project benchmark has been destroyed, **NTBA** will attempt to reestablish the existing benchmark vertical datum. However, if that is not achievable, a new benchmark is established by using Static GPS observations, NAVD 88, Geoid 18 or current vertical datum.

Prior to collection of data, a Sound Velocity Profiler is used to measure the speed of sound throughout a column of water as well as a level run from the project benchmark to the water level. These tests are also run every 3 hours for the duration of the survey to account for any tide fluctuations that may occur during that timeframe. The fathometer is also bar checked each day and calibrated to accurate readings. Recovering or reestablishing existing baselines and range lines using acceptable material will be completed. Then at each range line, the water's edge station is established based on the verified baseline. Only after all the checks are performed will the survey begin.

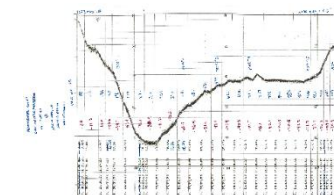
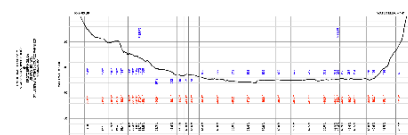
On larger rivers such as the Mississippi River or Atchafalaya River, **NTBA** utilizes **multibeam** technology to obtain more accurate data and

provide additional safety for our crews. The NORBIT Multibeam System is used and is equipped with two Trimble cards integrated into the system for positioning and for heading aiding. The antenna is RTK capable and uses the RTCM3 correctors to perform in RTK Narrow Lane mode. A HYPACK Project is created, and a plate Test performed to ensure all systems are operating properly and verify offsets have been correctly entered. A Patch Test is performed to determine the Roll, Pitch, and Yaw mounting angle. A 120° beam angle swath will be used for deeper water and a 160° beam angle swath for shallower water. Approximately 50% overlapping data between boat passes to ensure the best possible data.

Digital photography will be taken of the TBM used as well as the water level at the same location as previously taken to act as a verification of data. Photos are also taken of any debris around or against any portion of the bridge structure, banks, or revetment. The photos are annotated with structure number, direction photo was taken, date taken, and the bent number where photo was directed. If debris is located around a pier or piling or significant changes to the bottom, a photo and/or data will be sent to **LaDOTD** within twenty-four (24) hours for review by the engineer.



Once the crew returns to the office, the **single beam** charts are processed, the Bridge Data Chart (bdc) is completed, and the sketch of water's edge is produced by the CADD Technician. For **multibeam surveys**, data is post-processed using HYSWEEP Editor (MBMAX64) and a comma delimited XYZ file of the geo-referenced bathymetric survey, including the location of existing bridge footings or pilings is created in compliance with **LaDOTD's** feature code guidebook. From this, charts are produced using AutoCAD Civil 3D. For both types of survey, the Project Manager reviews the data and prepares a report for submission within 7 days of the survey.

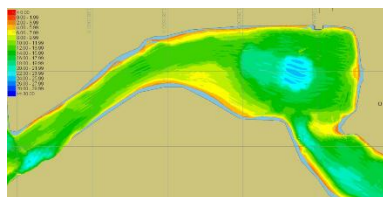
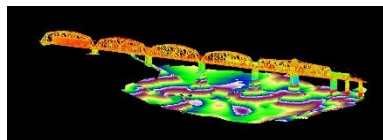

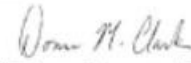
