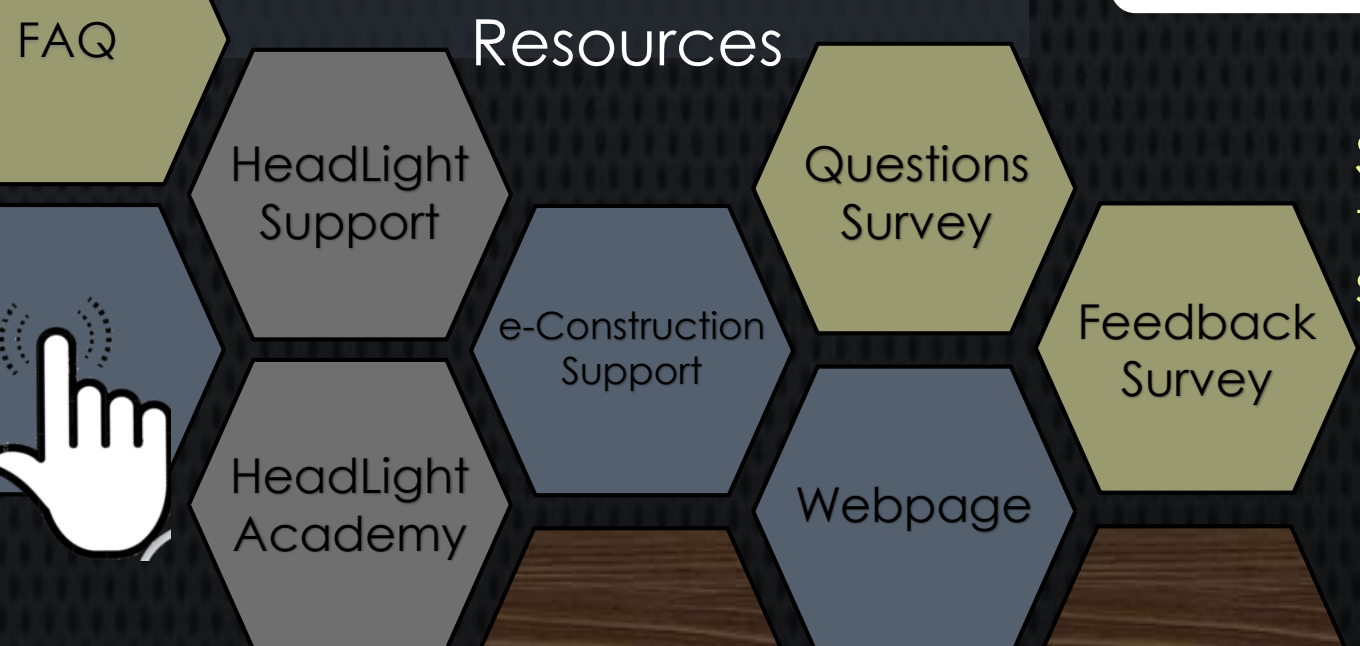

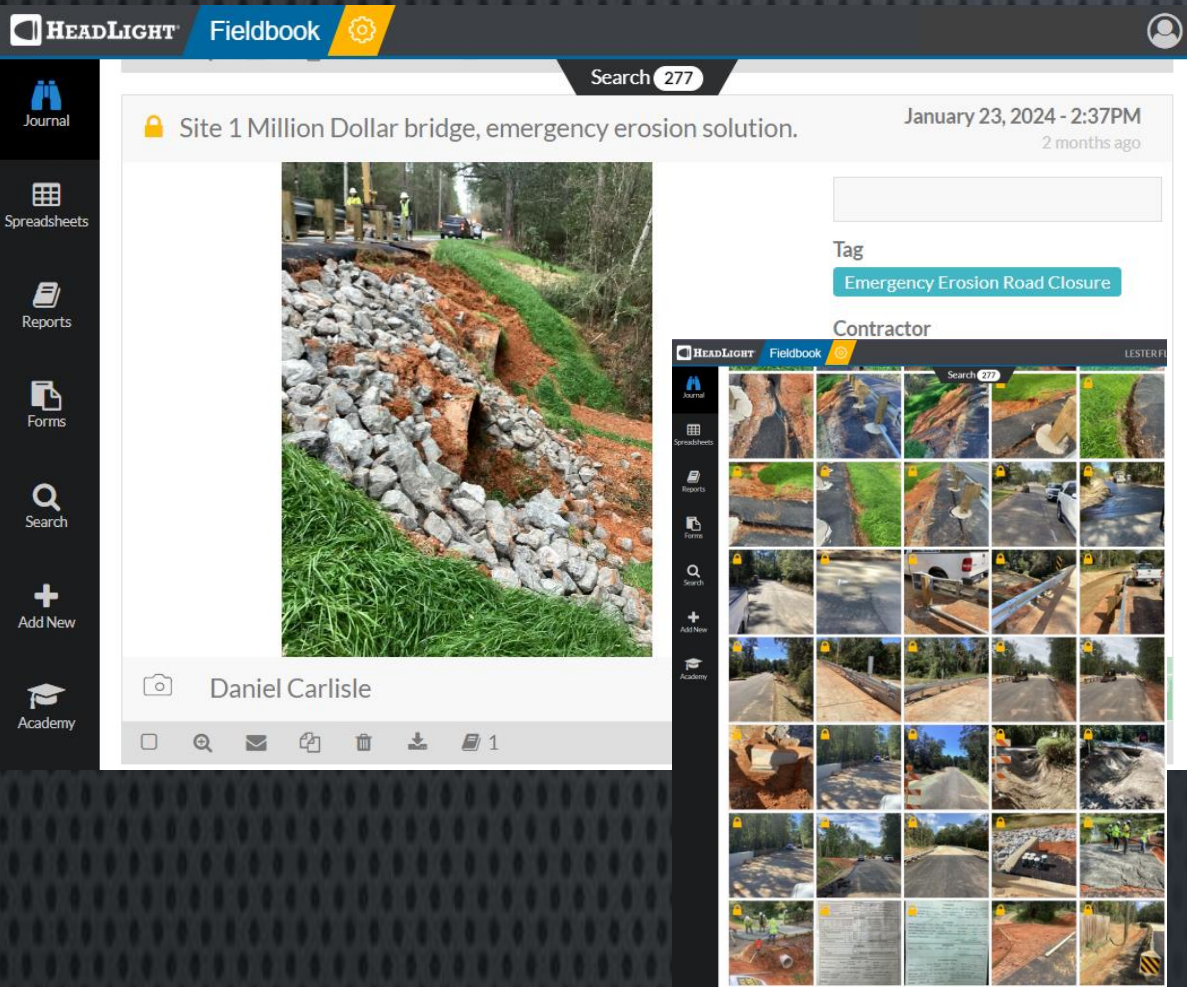
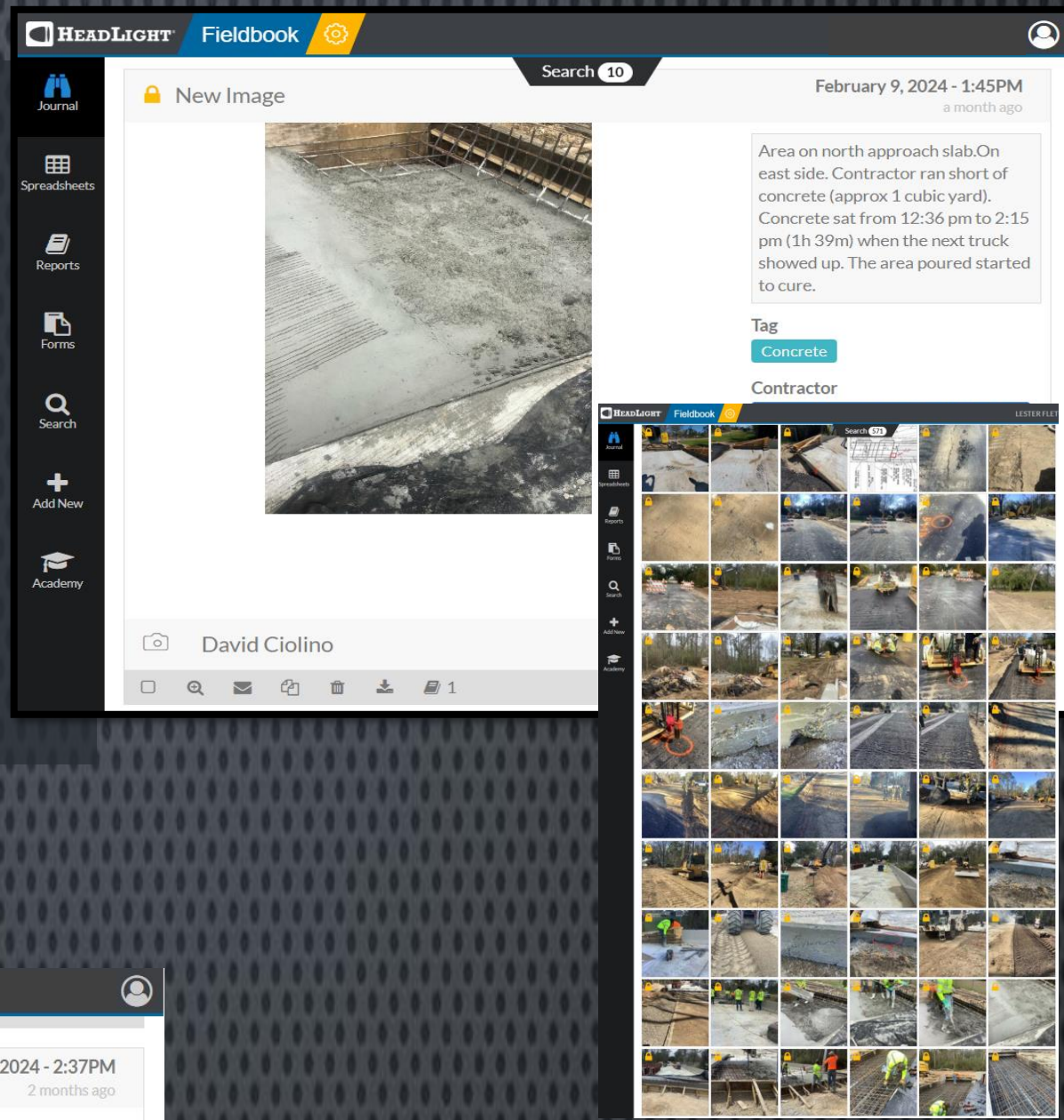
## HeadLight Heroes

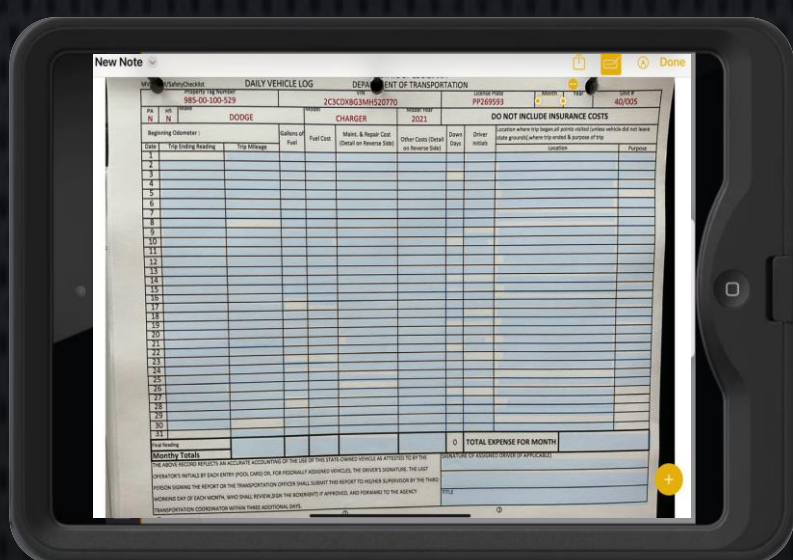
