

**NTBA** is performing topographic surveys, **property surveys**, **title take-offs**, **description preparations**, **preliminary and final right-of-way mapping** in support of design plans to replace the existing four-way stop with a roundabout. The scope of this project consists of constructing a new four lane structure carrying LA 511 across the Red River, converting LA 511 (Jimmie Davis Hwy) into a four-lane, mediandivided highway on the east side of bridge; as well as providing full access interchanges between LA 511 and Clyde Fant Memorial Parkway and Arthur Ray Teague Parkway. **NTBA** designed and implemented a Traffic Control Plan for a bridge closure to verify the horizontal and vertical control set by **LaDOTD** during the original survey and verified the vertical control for both sides by running digital levels across the bridge, which was not performed in the original survey.
