## SUBJECT: STRIPING OF RESEALED OR OVERLAYED PAVEMENTS USING MAINTENANCE FUNDS

- 1. PURPOSE: The purpose of this directive is to establish a uniform policy for District offices to follow when reporting sections of highway that have been resealed or overlayed by maintenance forces or by maintenance purchase order and are in need of restriping. Several methods are currently being used for this reporting and include various means of written correspondence, teletype, or telephone calls. Recent litigations involving the absence of pavement striping has prompted the need for a standard procedure for reporting that will provide for adequate means of notification and documentation.
- 2. SCOPE: This policy is applicable to all sections of roadway that have been resealed by maintenance forces or have been overlayed using maintenance funds. It does not apply to roadway sections that have been reconstructed or overlayed by contract.
- 3. PROCEDURE: The following procedure is hereby adopted for reporting sections of state maintained highway that are resealed or overlayed with maintenance funds. District Engineers and/or Assistant District Engineers in maintenance will be responsible for furnishing the Traffic Services Section with written notification of the resurfaced sections of roadway immediately after their completion. Correspondence will list the following information pertinent to the project:
  - A. Date of completion
  - B. Parish
  - C. Route number
  - D. Control section number
  - E. General description or beginning
  - F. Length (miles)
  - G. Type of surfacing
  - H. Required railroad grade crossing markings

An example of a letter containing the needed information is shown in Attachment A. Each District office is encouraged to develop a form letter similar to this example in order to make the notification as efficient as possible.

4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This directive will become effective immediately upon receipt.
