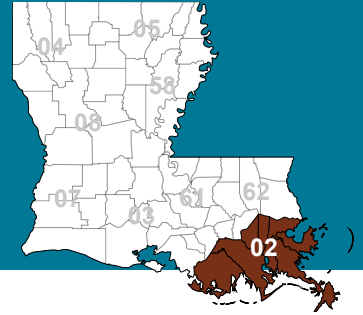

Equipment Purchase Received In District 02

The first piece of equipment purchased with supplemental funds was received in April. A 2026 O'Brien 7000 series off-road water jet (culvert/pipe cleaner) was added to the fleet at a cost of \$96,520.00. The portable nature of the equipment will allow crews to service culverts that an all-in-one pump truck may have difficulty reaching, and the 190-degree rotating hose reel provides easy access no matter how the trailer is

parked. The 700-gallon-capacity polyethylene water tanks allow longer jetting time on a single tank, as this model is designed for professional day-to-day pipe cleaning.

Patching Jobs Wrap Up Throughout District

Multiple pavement-patching projects were completed in April as all asphalt work finished. The U.S. 61 patching job in St. Charles Parish was awaiting final inspection in April. The LA 308 pavement patching job in Lafourche Parish finished in April with pavement markings being applied to the freshly asphalted roadway. This job also entered the final inspection phase. Contractor work has finished on the LA 428 patching job in Jefferson Parish, and district forces will complete the remaining striping work.

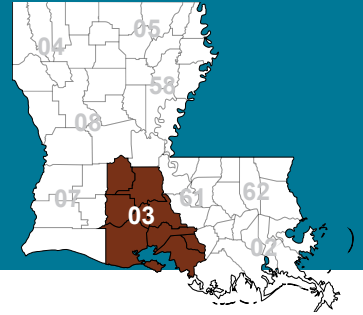
Fast Facts

Contracts

- \$32,280.25 was paid toward the District 03 guardrail repair contract this month for the repair of guardrail located on LA 115 in Evangeline Parish, I-49 in St. Landry and Lafayette parishes, LA 13 in Acadia Parish, U.S. 90 St. in Mary Parish, and LA 723 in Lafayette Parish.
- Maintenance mowing/litter and sweeping contract cycles:
 - I-10 from I-49 across the basin bridge to Ramah (additional cycles through end of FY 26, including median concrete barrier): \$14,510.53
- The cross-drain lining deterioration repair contract for \$829,500.00 is scheduled to begin in mid-May.
- A surface treatment contract for milling for \$25,997.40 supported an in-house overlay project on LA 3242 in Iberia Parish.
- Additional bridge undersealing pavement repair locations are to be completed in Acadia, Iberia, Lafayette, and St Landry parishes, increasing the \$429,110.00 contract by an estimated \$90,000.00.
- A contract for \$433,861.51 has been awarded to overlay the I-10 westbound Duson off-ramp (Exit 92) in Acadia Parish.
- The \$267,583.71 cross-drain replacement contract for LA 13 in St. Landry Parish was completed this month.

Materials

- \$39,075.00 expensed on asphalt in support of an overlay project on LA 682 in Iberia Parish.
- \$6,506.55 expensed on asphalt to smooth transitions between roadway and bridge decks on LA 82 in Vermilion Parish.
- \$7,901.04 expensed for fuel cost for rental equipment in support of overlay projects and other in-house maintenance work.
- An additional \$7,599.78 was spent on the repair of district paving equipment.
- \$43,589.26 expensed for moveable bridge parts and services (transit gate arm extensions, barrier replacement or repair, barrier and thruster motor repair, limit switches, joints, etc.).

Equipment

- \$134,410.47 expensed for monthly equipment rentals (dump trucks, bucket trucks, rollers, sweepers, lifts, etc.) and repairs.

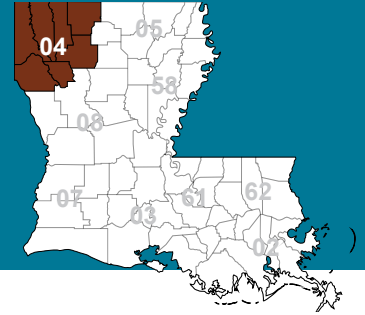

Red River and DeSoto Parishes Overlay

Hot mixing jobs are still occurring in District 04.

990.8 tons of asphalt were poured over 1.38 miles of LA 788 in Red River Parish for \$114,695.20.

U.S. 71 in Red River Parish was also overlaid. 1.55 miles of highway received 972.21 tons of hot mix at a cost of \$106,577.89.

DOTD hot mix crews moved to DeSoto Parish where they started milling and pouring hot mix. 0.88 miles of LA 175 had 638.19 tons of hot mix poured for \$69,562.71.

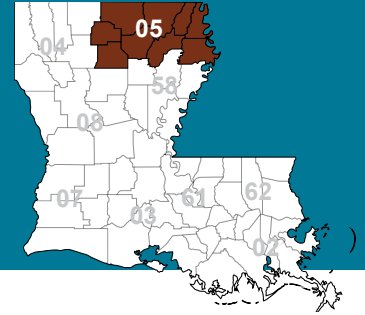

Roadway Improvements: Overlay and Pavement Projects

LA 511 (West 70th Street) Concrete Patching in Caddo Parish (Project 4400033230.6)

The LA 511 (West 70th Street) project in Caddo Parish continues. There was some roadway patching performed, but the majority of the month was spent pouring curbs.

Lincoln Parish Pavement Striping

Pavement striping took place in Lincoln Parish on multiple routes covering a combined total of 177.48 lane miles. This project used 2,375 gallons of yellow and 1,145 gallons of white paint. The cost of paint totaled \$41,047.25.

Radar Detection Upgrades

Districtwide signal crews installed radar detection upgrades at seven intersections in the district at a cost of \$63,178.00.

Asphalt Projects in Lincoln, Richland, and West Carroll

West Carroll Parish crews have been busy making repairs to LA 134. Full-depth patching repairs in West Carroll used 150.79 tons of asphalt to patch and fill multiple spots along this route. Asphalt for this project cost \$14,502.29.

Richland Parish, with the help of the districtwide crew, used 4,848.7 tons of asphalt on overlay jobs on LA 135 and LA 133. Asphalt cost: \$552,751.80.

The Lincoln Parish crew and the districtwide crew worked together to complete hot mix overlay jobs on LA 3005, LA 151, and LA 822. A combined total of 5,072.3 tons of asphalt were used to complete these overlay jobs, totaling \$578,242.20.

New Equipment Purchase

The Barber Road Rake Model 200 was purchased using supplemental funds. This equipment will be used by Unit 760 to keep roads and shoulders clear of debris. The cost of the road rake was \$111,145.00.

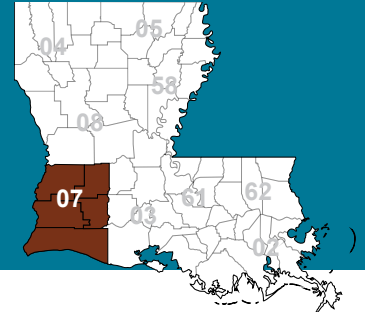

In-House Cross-Drain Replacement

In April, the Jennings maintenance unit replaced a cross drain on LA 14 in Lake Arthur. Supplemental funds were used to purchase 40 feet of corrugated pipe, 11.9 tons of hot mix asphalt, and 10 gallons of cationic emulsion. Total cost in materials: \$2,741.

Maintenance Materials

The Calcasieu maintenance unit full-depth patched on LA 12 near the Starks weigh station. Fifteen tons of hot mix asphalt and three gallons of cationic emulsion were used at this location. Cost: \$1,703.

The Creole maintenance unit full-depth patched multiple locations on LA 27 near Creole. Fifty-five tons of hot mix asphalt and 11 gallons of cationic emulsion were used for a cost of \$6,277.

Traffic Signal Upgrades

District 07 signal crews replaced a damaged signal cabinet at the intersection of LA 14 and Legion Street in Lake Charles. Supplemental funding was used to purchase this cabinet. Total cost: \$8,119.

In April, radar detection was upgraded at two intersections in Calcasieu Parish: U.S. 90 at Maple Street in Sulphur and LA 384 at Weaver Road in Lake Charles. Supplemental funds total: \$58,480.

At the intersection of U.S. 90 and U.S. 171 in Lake Charles, signal heads were changed out with polycarbonate material. This material is lighter than traditional signal heads and allows for greater vertical clearance. Material cost: \$6,809.

Contracted Work

Prairie Contractors began milling on LA 27 in Sulphur. The awarded bid amount is \$133,427 and consists of 0.97 miles of asphalt pavement milling. In-house forces will follow with hot mix asphalt overlay.

BLD Services began work on culvert rehabilitation in Beauregard Parish. Geopolymer spray liner is being applied to steel pipe cross drains at two locations. Bid amount: \$343,200.

Guardrail contract repairs totaling \$99,338 were made in April at 20 locations throughout the district.

Ditch cleaning on LA 397 in Calcasieu continues by the contractor, Traffic Commander. Supplemental funds paid to date: \$268,505.

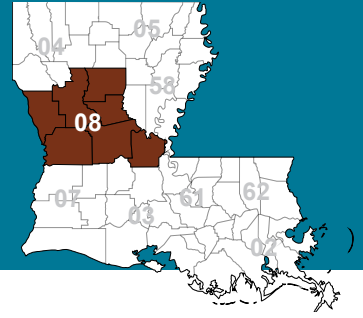

Patch, Mill, and Overlay Projects

In April, in-house crews milled and overlaid a section of LA 107 in Avoyelles Parish using 196.3 tons of hot mix asphalt at a cost of \$19,924.45. In Natchitoches Parish, in-house crews completed work on LA 485 using 329.95 tons of hot mix asphalt at a cost of \$35,964.55. In Rapides Parish, in-house crews completed an overlay project on LA 1208-1 and U.S. 71 using 109.09 tons of hot mix asphalt at a cost of \$11,072.64.

Cable Barrier and Guardrail Repair

Supplemental funds are being used to repair damaged cable barrier and guardrail throughout the district in order to ensure roadway safety. In April, one section of guardrail in Natchitoches Parish was repaired by a contractor at a cost of \$6,000.00. Guardrail on LA 114, LA 175, LA 454, U.S. 167, and two sections of guardrail on I-49 were repaired by in-house crews at a cost of \$690.80. Additionally, three sections of cable barrier on I-49 were repaired by in-house crews at a cost of \$794.60.

Mowing/Litter Pickup

In April, \$2,812.50 was spent for additional mowing cycles on state routes within the village of Atlanta in Winn Parish and the village of Hessmer in Avoyelles Parish. \$54,425.51 was spent on additional mowing and litter-pickup cycles on U.S. 71, U.S. 165, U.S. 167, and LA 28 in Rapides Parish.

Pavement Striping/Raised Pavement Marker Application Projects

District 08 continued using supplemental funds on pavement striping/raised pavement marker improvement projects across the district in April. In-house crews completed projects in Rapides and Winn parishes. In Rapides, an estimated 720 linear feet of roadway were striped on LA 623 and LA 3325 using hot tape. In Winn Parish, Unit 771 placed 15,800 raised pavement markers on LA 34, LA 124, LA 126, LA 471, LA 499, LA 1288, and U.S. 84. Pavement striping and raised pavement marker application projects cost \$16,732.02 in April.

Sign Repair/Replacement

In April, in-house crews replaced/repared 336 damaged signs/posts throughout the district in an effort to maintain roadway safety on the following routes:

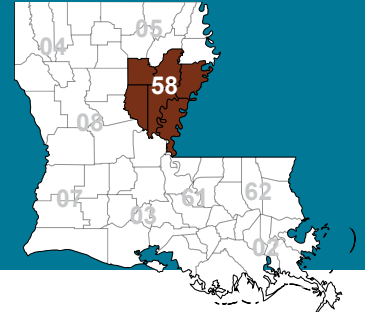

Hot Mix Overlay and Patching

District 58 crews completed three asphalt overlay projects this month:

- A three-mile segment of LA 128 in Tensas was paved at a cost of \$458,887.51.
- A two-mile segment of LA 459 in LaSalle was paved at a cost of \$273,834.94.
- A 0.75-mile segment of LA 605 in Tensas was paved at a cost of \$103,455.92.

One last in-house project using the additional funds was patching the approach to a bridge on LA 568 in Concordia Parish. The total additional funds cost of this project was \$9,639.46.

Microsurfacing Contracts

Two microsurfacing contracts, both with Vance Brothers on U.S. 84 and LA 130, were substantially completed. These two projects in Catahoula and Franklin parishes will cost \$705,487.46 and \$623,033.58, respectively, when all invoices are paid.

Tree Removal

Alison Enterprises, LLC began work on the tree removal contract for Franklin, Caldwell, and Tensas parishes. Eighteen trees and stumps were removed on the LA 128 right-of-way in Franklin Parish. Traffic Commander, LLC also began cutting trees on the rights-of-way on U.S. 165, LA 8, LA 126, and LA 772 in the tree removal contract for LaSalle, Catahoula, and Concordia parishes. Eleven trees were topped and 141 trees were removed.

Equipment

Two new pieces of equipment were delivered to District 58 in April: a self-propelled sweeper broom for Unit 710 at a cost of \$102,389.00, and a large 81-horsepower Kubota off-road tractor for Unit 765 at a cost of \$96,091.80.

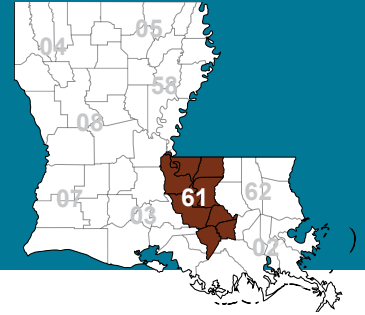

Drainage Structure Replacement

Drainage structures were replaced on LA 22 and U.S. 61 in Ascension Parish.

Asphalt and Patching

Fresh asphalt was applied to turn lanes on U.S. 190 (Florida Boulevard) in East Baton Rouge Parish, and a segment at Sherwood Forest Drive was milled and prepped.

Tree Removal

Stump removal and tree trimming finished on LA 69 and LA 70 in Assumption Parish, and also along LA 75 and LA 76 in Iberville Parish.

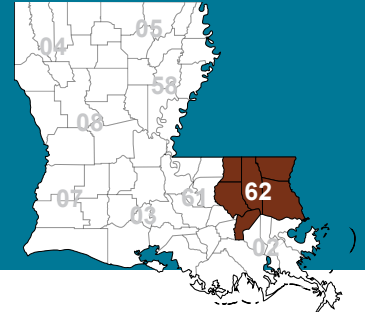

Radar Detection

Radar detection equipment was installed on LA 16 in Livingston Parish and on LA 59 and U.S. 190B in St. Tammany Parish.

Guardrail Repair

Repairs took place on guardrail along LA 22, LA 64, and U.S. 190 in Livingston Parish, LA 38 in St. Helena Parish, I-12 in St. Tammany Parish, and along LA 22, LA 440, I-55, and U.S. 51 in Tangipahoa Parish.

Asphalt Overlay

Over 2,300 tons of asphalt were laid down on LA 433 (Old Spanish Trail) in St. Tammany Parish.

Striping

LA 63 in St. Helena Parish was restriped from LA 16 to LA 37, along with LA 37 from the Amite River Bridge to LA 10 in Greensburg. New striping was applied to the fresh overlays in St. Tammany Parish on LA 433, LA 435, and LA 1088 after the temporary striping was removed. LA 59 was restriped from LA 12 to LA 36. LA 434 was also restriped from LA 36 to U.S. 190.

Ditch Cleaning

More than 21,000 linear feet of ditches and 6,000 linear feet of pipe were cleaned along LA 1040 in Tangipahoa Parish.

Tree Trimming

Over 200 trees were removed from the right-of-way on LA 16 in Livingston Parish and numerous routes in St. Helena Parish.
